To amend title 38, United States Code, to strengthen benefits for children of Vietnam veterans born with spina bifida, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN CHILDREN OF VIET-
- 4 NAM VETERANS AND CERTAIN OTHER VET-

- 6 (a) Definitions.—Section 1831 of title 38, United
- 7 States Code, is amended—
- 8 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (2) and (3) as
- 9 paragraphs (4) and (5), respectively; and

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2 1 (2) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-2 lowing new paragraphs: 3 "(2) The term 'covered child' means a child who is eligible for health care and benefits under 4 5 this chapter. 6 "(3) The term 'covered veteran' means an indi-7 vidual whose children are eligible for health care and 8 benefits under this chapter.". 9 (b) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter IV of chapter 18 of 10 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new sections: 11 12 "§ 1835. Advisory council 13 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall establish an 14 advisory council on health care and benefits for covered 15 children. 16 Duties.—The advisory council established under subsection (a) shall solicit feedback from covered 18 children and covered veterans on the health care and bene-19 fits provided under this chapter and communicate such 20 feedback to the Secretary. "§ 1836. Care and coordination teams

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- 22 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall establish
- care and coordination teams for covered children.

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1	"(b) Outreach.—A care and coordination team es-
2	tablished under subsection (a) shall contact each covered
3	child—
4	"(1) not less frequently than once every 180
5	days, to ensure the continued care of the child and
6	assist with any changes in care needed due to a
7	changed situation of the child; and
8	"(2) as soon as practicable after the identifica-
9	tion of a condition listed in the report required by
10	subsection (c).
11	"(c) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the
12	date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary shall
13	submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Sen-
14	ate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the House
15	of Representatives a report setting forth a list of condi-
16	tions that will trigger outreach to covered children under
17	subsection $(b)(2)$.
18	"§ 1837. Duration of health care and benefits pro-
19	vided
20	"The Secretary shall provide a covered child with
21	health care and benefits under this chapter—
22	"(1) for the duration of the life of the child;
23	and
24	"(2) notwithstanding any death of a parent of
25	the child that precedes the death of the child.".

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1	(c) Memorandum of Understanding.—Not later
2	than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
3	the Under Secretary for Benefits of the Department of
4	Veterans Affairs and the Under Secretary for Health of
5	the Department shall enter into a memorandum of under-
6	standing—
7	(1) to better assist covered children (as defined
8	in section 1831 of title 38, United States Code, as
9	amended by subsection (a)); and
10	(2) to establish conditions to be included in the
11	report required by section 1836(c) of title 38,
12	United States Code, as added by subsection (b).
13	(d) Implementation.—Not later than 90 days after
14	the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
15	Veterans Affairs shall establish—
16	(1) the advisory council required under section
17	1835 of title 38, United States Code, as added by
18	subsection (b); and
19	(2) the care and coordination teams required
20	under section 1836 of such title, as so added.
21	(e) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
22	at the beginning of chapter 18 of title 38, United States
23	Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
24	items:
