3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Applicant Medical Re-
5 imbursement Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. REIMBURSEMENT OF APPLICANTS FOR UNIFORM**
2 **MILITARY SERVICE FOR CO-PAYS OF MED-**
3 **ICAL APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED AS PART OF**
4 **MEPS PROCESS.**

5 The Secretary of Defense is authorized to reimburse
6 applicants for uniformed military service for up to \$100
7 per applicant for co-payment costs incurred by such appli-
8 cants for medical appointments required as part of the
9 Military Entrance Processing Station (MEPS) process.
