SERVICE ACADEMY NOMINATIONS

U.S. SENATOR TODD YOUNG

Members of Congress have the privilege of recommending a select group of individuals for admission to the United States service academies. Each year, Senator Young is honored to nominate a number of highly-qualified young Hoosiers to our nation's service academies.

HOW TO APPLY

- Attend an Academy Day information session. While not required, these meetings can help students learn more about their options.
- During junior year, students should apply to chosen academies.
- Students should complete the application at <u>young.senate.gov/academies</u> before the October deadline of their senior year.
- Top candidates will interview with the Academy Nominations Review Board in November.

REVIEW PROCESS

- Senator Young appoints service academy alumni, community leaders, and current and former members of the armed services to his Academy Nominations Review Board to help make objective recommendations for nominations.
- Nominees are chosen based on personal merit. Criteria considered include evidence of character, leadership, academic excellence, physical aptitude, and extracurricular activities.
- A Congressional nomination does not guarantee admission or an appointment to a service academy.
